Style Guide for the Pre-Print Publication of the 15<sup>th</sup> International Saga Conference

It is possible to submit abstracts of your paper or poster to the Pre-Print Publication of the 15<sup>th</sup> International Saga Conference. The abstracts must be submitted electronically to <a href="mailto:sagaconference@hum.au.dk">sagaconference@hum.au.dk</a> no later than the 1<sup>st</sup> of May 2012. If you do not take advantage of this possibility, the abstract that you have already sent and which has been accepted will be used for the Pre-Print Publication.

To ensure the best possible editorial process we kindly ask you to follow the specifications below:

For paper presentations, abstracts for the Pre-Print Publication must be no longer than two pages (800 words) and for poster presentations, abstracts for the Pre-Print Publication must be no longer than five pages (2,000 words). One page is defined as 400 words (be aware of the limit, as we will not publish texts that exceed the allowed number of words), including possible bibliographic information and notes. However, we kindly ask you to avoid or limit the use of notes. Use Times New Roman, font size 12, and submit abstracts for the Pre-Print Publication in Word-format.

Please, mention the paper title/poster title, the author(s) name(s) and institution(s) at the top of the first page; this information is not included in the allowed number of words.

## Special characters

To ensure the correct realisation of special characters, please use the following fonts for those. We cannot guarantee the correct appearance of special characters written with other fonts.

- For runic texts: Gullskoen and Gullhornet
- For Old Norse special characters not available in Times New Roman: Reykjavik Times and Akureyri Times
- For Phonetic script: Charis SIL, Release 4.106
- For Greek characters: GFS Porson
